## Who can be a school governor?

- You must be over 18 to be a school governor. No formal qualifications are needed.
- Governors are volunteers from all backgrounds. Use your skills and experience to enable children to have the best possible education.
- An effective Board of Governors has people from different backgrounds with a mix of skills and experience.
- Governors do not need to be education experts your skills and experience from your personal and professional life can add value to a school.

## What makes a good governor?

- Important qualities for being a school governor are enthusiasm, commitment, the ability to work in a team and a desire to help ensure that children get the best possible education.
- Governors need a strong commitment to the role and to improving educational outcomes for children and young people.
- A willingness to listen, to learn and to undertake training.
